Vice President, Distribution Operations

June S. Youngs is the Vice President of Distribution Operations at CVS Caremark, located in Woonsocket, RI. CVS Caremark is dedicated to helping people on their path to better health as the largest integrated pharmacy company in the United States. The company had more than \$123 billion in annual revenue for 2012 and ranked 13th on the Fortune 500.

Youngs is responsible for oversight of DC Operations for half of the Logistics network which service 7500 stores, representing nine Distribution Centers, Directors, and thirty five hundred associates. This role collaborates with the SVP of Logistics to develop and implement strategies that enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of distribution operations to include enhancing store service levels and productivity as well as the overall P&L. In this role, she partners with other retail leaders in Store Operations, Inventory and Merchandising to develop and implement strategies that drive sales, margin, inventory optimization and service to CVS Caremark and their customers.

Prior to joining CVS Caremark, Youngs was the Director of North American Supply Chain for Ocean Spray Cranberries, Inc., a \$2.1 billion consumer packaged goods company and agricultural cooperative owned by more than 700 cranberry growers and 70 Florida grapefruit growers. In this role, Youngs oversaw planning, implementation and optimization of all activities and support required for the delivery of raw materials through finished products. This included oversight of contract manufacturing, transportation, supply, material, demand and production planning, and inventory control in the US and Canada, and customer service operations worldwide.

Additionally at Ocean Spray, Youngs had been Director of Manufacturing, overseeing four product manufacturing facilities as well as receiving station operations and co-packer and alliance partners, to meet the manufacturing objectives of the organization with maximum efficiency. For three years prior, she had been Director of US Supply Chain.

Before joining Ocean Spray, Youngs was Chief Operating Officer and a member of the Board of Boston Warehouse Trading Corporation, a privately-held fine housewares and gifts company. In this role, Youngs oversaw domestic and overseas business operations including finance, distribution and logistics, imports, information technology, human resources, and office management.

Youngs was also Senior Vice President of Global Supply Chain and Logistics for Hasbro, Inc., and a director of transportation/distribution services for Nabisco.

An expert in the logistics industry listed in the Who's Who of American Women, Youngs was named one of the Top 20 Logistics' Professionals in 2000. In 2007 she received the "Women of Influence in the Northeast" award from the Griffin Report of Food Marketing. She has been cover-featured in *Chief Logistics Officer* magazine and was the first female chairperson of the National Industrial Transportation League.

Youngs is on the Board of Visitors for Northeastern University's School of Business and the Supply Chain Advisory Boards for both Northeastern University and the University of Rhode Island, where she is also an adjunct professor. She is a past Vice Chair and member of the Board of both the New England Chapter of the National Industrial Transportation League and the Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals. She is also a member of the Network of Executive Women, National Association of Female Executives, and the American Association of University Women.

Youngs earned an MBA from Boston University and a bachelor's degree from Moravian College in Pennsylvania. She holds certification in Import/Export Operations from the World Trade Institute in New York, and in Transportation from Middlesex County College in New Jersey. Youngs lives in southeastern Rhode Island with her husband and son.
